THE CLP CORPORATION/McDONALD'S® SCHOLARSHIP

If you qualify you will be entitled to **one McDonald's Scholarship a year only for the entire academic year commencing immediately after you fulfill all of the requirements.** The scholarship will be paid directly to the college or university that you attend and will be applied to expenses incurred for your tuition, books and on campus food and lodging. The Scholarship will be paid directly to any two year or four year degree granting institution accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Universities providing that you are enrolled as a student and are working toward a degree. In the event you withdraw from college for any reason before using the full Scholarship, any balance remaining in the Scholarship fund will be refunded by the college to us.

You may earn additional McDonald's Scholarships by working at any CLP Corporation McDonald's Restaurant while you attend college. All you have to do is re-apply and again fulfill the requirements of the Program. However, each applicant can only be awarded a total of **four (4) McDonald's Scholarships.**

This Scholarship Program is not a contract. CLP Corporation reserves the right to cancel or amend the Program effective June 30th of any year, in which even the Program will continue only through the cancellation date and will only apply to applicants who have completed all McDonald's Scholarship work, academic and other requirements on the cancellation date. Participation in the McDonald's Scholarship Program is subject to job availability, and your employment and job performance is subject to the same requirements applicable to employees not participating in the McDonald's Scholarship program.

ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible for a McDonald's Scholarship to be applied toward the cost of attending an accredited degree granting institution of your choice if you meet all of the following requirements:

You are a high school graduate or you have received your GED Certification, or you are a freshman, sophomore or junior at an accredited degree granting institution.

You remain on our payroll for at least 50 weeks during any one year period preceding your application for scholarship. This 50 week period begins July 1st and ends June 30th of the following year.

You work for us **at least 1,000 hours** (i.e., an average of 20 hours a week for 50 weeks) and you must be available for **Saturday or Sunday work when scheduled.**

During **your last completed school year you maintained at least a C+ average of 2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA)** in your studies, verified by a certified copy of your transcript for the school you attended.

The Scholarship amount will be based on your academic performance. The Scholarship amount ranges from a minimum of \$1,000 up to a maximum amount of \$2,000. The GPA minimum requirement is 2.5.

You meet the work requirements at any of the McDonald's restaurants operated by CLP Corporation. These locations include **some** McDonald's restaurants in Jefferson, Shelby, St. Clair, Etowah and Calhoun Counties. Work prior to July 1st, or at McDonald's locations that **are not operated by CLP Corporations cannot be credited towards the McDonald's Scholarship Program.**

If you average 35 or more hours a week but are unable to work a Saturday or Sunday due to extraordinary circumstances, and meet all other requirements, the Store Manager may waive that requirement and approve your eligibility.

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE McDONALD'S SCHOLARSHIP

After you have worked for CLP Corporation/McDonald's for the 50 week period beginning July 1 of the preceding year and ending June 30th of the current year, you may apply for the Scholarship in the following manner:

Request a scholarship Application from your Store Manager and completely fill it out. **DO NOT LEAVE ANY SPACES BLANK!**

Request a certified transcript of your grades for the last completed school year for the school you attended.

Attach the application to the transcript of your grades and mail them by June 30th to:
